

Vocation Poster Contest Q & A

What are the dimensions of the poster?

Posters should be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 11" x 17."

What type of art medium may be used?

All posters should be hand-drawn which consists of artwork that uses pencil, paint, markers, crayons, etc.

What should be included in the poster?

Students are encouraged to use Scripture verses, slogans, catchy phrases, or other words to highlight the promotion of vocations.

How will the poster be judged?

The parish judges can use the enclosed rubric to give their students a grade. The diocesan judges will base winners on creativity, craftsmanship, effort, overall vocation message, and overall poster appearance.

How many entries can we submit?

Each parish may submit three (3) posters. The diocesan judges will then decide on the top fifteen (15) entries as the winners.

How do we submit entries?

To submit the posters, *mail* them to the <u>Office of Vocations</u> (7200 Stonehenge Drive, Raleigh, NC 27613). Please ensure that each entry has the student's name, parish/city, and grade on the back of the poster. Winning posters will be returned to the students on the day of the luncheon.

When are the posters due?

All entries must be submitted to the Office of Vocations (7200 Stonehenge Drive, Raleigh, NC 27613) and **postmarked by Friday**, **December 13**th.

When will we find out the winners?

The announcement of winners will take place by the end of January.
